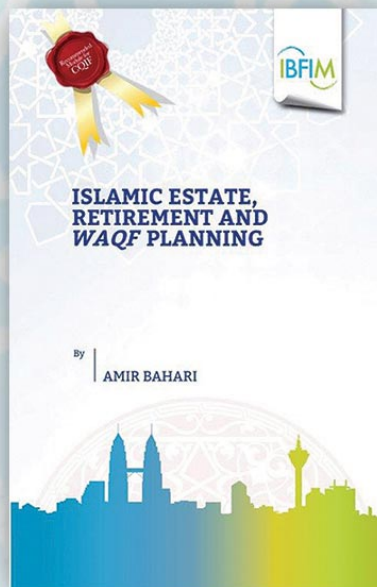


Islamic Estate, Retirement and Waqf Planning
